The Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency (OOD) is a state agency that has been helping eligible Ohioans with disabilities find and retain jobs since 1970. OOD offers a wide range of services through the Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation and Bureau of Services for the Visually Impaired. Each year OOD's team of professional counselors and community partners work with thousands of eligible Ohioans with disabilities to reach their employment goals.



How OOD helps Veterans

Vocational rehabilitation (VR) counselors at OOD develop individual employment plans that match your skills and interests to career goals. OOD offers:

- Job training and counseling;
- Assistive technology and vehicle modifications;
- Offices statewide;
- Network of community rehabilitation partners; and
- Informed choice – You choose your VR plan.

Ability comes before disability

OOD focuses on your ability, not your disability. People served by OOD have many types of disabilities, such as brain injury, post-traumatic stress disorder, blind or low vision, loss of limbs, depression, learning difficulty, mental illness, deafness or hearing loss, drug or alcohol dependence, mobility loss, diabetes, blood diseases, speech impairment, epilepsy, nerve disorders, emotional disorders and others.
